Gloria Horton called the meeting to order at 1 PM .

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

PSA Licensure Update: Todd reported the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) now has 240 licensed PSA's in the state. These PSA's are available to view on the in.gov/isdh website. If providers have knowledge of some practicing without a license should report to ISDH. ISDH in turn will send a letter to cease and desist. ISDH is limited in their manpower to pursue any other action, but can report to the Attorney General's office that can impose penalties and fines.

Legislative Update:

Good News: IAHHC's Criminal Background Check Bill passed! And Independent Provider government subsidy bill did not.

Bad News: Mary Ann Maroon has left the association for a corporate regional director position. Rebecca Kasper will assume the role of lobbyist June 1.

The committee discussed problems with Independent Providers and the white paper in development.

The PAC is setting a goal to raise \$25,000 to counter the SEIU's campaign to promote independent providers.

Client & Employee Satisfaction: Todd Stallings followed up on the client and employee satisfaction surveys program through Home Care Pulse.

Education Update: Conference was very successful with a two-day track for PSA and private duty.
